



AppSkil: European ICT Sector Skills Alliance VET Open Course for Mobile Apps Creators

AppSkil Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) defines the terms and understanding between the signatory institutions.

Background

In the framework of the AppSkil Project, the skills most needed but missing from the mobile apps' labour market have been identified, and a suitable curriculum and MOOC have been developed, to offer industry-specific training to mobile app developers.

The AppSkil Project partners pursued its enlargement towards the establishment of a European ICT Sector Skills Council, for a continuous monitoring of the mobile apps development sector, with the aim of anticipating future skills needs, and responding to them.

In 2016 the European Commission launched the Digital Skills and Jobs Coalition, with the aim to build strong partnerships and work together to reduce digital skills gaps in Europe.

Goals

The purpose of this MoU is to articulate the bases and general principles for cooperation among the signatory institutions, to promote the AppSkil project results.

The signatory institutions recognize the benefits to be achieved through cooperation, for ensuring a future use of the AppSkil project results, also with the aim to produce a multiplier effect.
